Throughout corporate prayer we will be praying in the spirit (Eph. 6:18) and worshiping the Lord. Our prayer agenda will include:

- The prayer of Adoration and Thanksgiving – Ps. 100 and Ps. 96:1-9
- Decreeing and declaring that from our perpetual posture of worship there will be fresh creativity and flow of ideas that when acted upon will create uncommon streams of increase and wealth – Eph. 3:20
- SOFCC's Pastoral gifts – 1 Kings 4:29, Eph. 3:2-7, Ps. 101:6, and 3 John 1:2
- Our new Baltimore location and Pastor DeWayne as Pastor Mike's appointed location leader – 1 Chr. 28:10, Is. 54:2, 1 Chr. 22:19, and Ezek. 36:34-37

- The President of the United States and all government leaders – 1 Tim. 2:1-4, Prov. 21:1, and 1 Chr. 7:14
- Law enforcement officers – Prov. 29:2 and Rom. 13:1-3
- Justice for the innocent, mercy for the guilty who are repentant and have had a change of heart, and for unjust judicial decisions to be overturned – Ps. 33:5, Ps. 89:14, and Ps. 103:6
- The unsaved and the backslidden – Ps. 2:8, Matt. 9:38, 2 Cor. 4:4, Lk. 15:4, Hos 14:4 and Jer. 3:14
- The fear of the Lord returning to the body of Christ – Prov. 1:7, Ps. 15:33, and Prov. 22:4
- Other topics as led by Holy Spirit

Come with expectation on August 9 and remember things always happen when we **pray, praise and worship** – together!!”
