

COVID-19 Protocols and Processes

“What we have done to protect our partners”

- Continuous review and implementation of state and county COVID guidelines
- Creation of the initial Reopening Plan (Nov 2020)
- Dissemination of COVID protocol updates to leadership and MOLs
- Thorough building logistics assessments of all campuses to determine safe entry/exit and traffic flow for attendees
- Check-in requirement for all worship service attendees
- Mandatory wearing of masks
- Hand sanitizing stations located throughout the building
- Placement of physical distancing markers
- Physical distancing of sanctuary seating
- Placement of COVID protocol signage at building entrances
- Placement of limited capacity signage on restroom doors
- Continuous sanitization of restrooms throughout worship services
- Discontinued distribution of communion cups in the sanctuary; self-disposal required at dismissal
- Discontinued passing of offering buckets and envelopes in the sanctuary as online giving is encouraged; self-deposit of envelopes required at dismissal
- Distribution of pre-bagged communion cups, offering envelopes, gift bags at check-in before entering the sanctuary.
- Distribution of colored wristband upon entry, based on level of comfort
 - Red – No Contact
 - Yellow – Elbows Only
 - Green – Hugs & High Fives

 - Optional designated seating area for ‘red-banded’ attendees that are not comfortable amongst other attendees or partners with breathing challenges. NOTE: Seating in the section is limited.
